With this website scavenger hunt, learners will practice researching, reading and web literacy skills to learn information about the history of the Zoo and the animals that live there.

Use our website, www.fresnochaffeezoo.org, and search the links and menus to see if you can find all ten items!

- 1. The Fresno Chaffee Zoo just celebrated a big anniversary. How many years has the Zoo been open?
- 2. Sea Lion Cove was one of the first projects built with Measure Z funding. What year did Sea Lion Cove open?
- 3. Enrichment is something Fresno Chaffee Zoo offers to our animals. See if you can find the six types of enrichment we use at the Zoo!
- 4. Fresno Chaffee Zoo is home to an important species of bird: Guam rails. What is the status of Guam rails in the wild?
- 5. Our Zoo is home to over 190 different species of animals! Can you find Africa's heaviest venomous snake on our site?
- 6. About how many endangered species live at the Fresno Chaffee Zoo?
- 7. Learning is always an adventure at the Zoo! See if you can find an activity we share that you can do at home.
- 8. Can you find some of the programs the Zoo supports through our Wildlife Conservation Fund? Pick one and read up about it. You might learn about some of the important conservation work happening in the wild, and maybe discover a new favorite animal!
- 9. Explore some of the animals who live at the Zoo. Which species is the heaviest carnivore?
