WHITE RHINO CALF BORN AT FRESNO CHAFFEE ZOO

WHAT: White Rhino Calf Born at Fresno Chaffee Zoo

INFO: Fresno Chaffee Zoo's white rhino, Kayla has given birth to a male calf. This is Kayla's fourth

calf that she has had while at Fresno Chaffee Zoo. Both mom and baby are doing well and are

currently out on the savanna in African Adventure.

Southern white rhinos are found in regions of Africa and their populations are considered "near threatened" with extinction according to the IUCN Red List. Fresno Chaffee Zoo works with International Rhino Foundation to support conservation and research programs focused on ensuring the long-term survival of the five remaining rhino species throughout Africa and Asia.

Guests can continue to receive updates on the new addition on the Zoo's social media channels and can see the calf and mom out on the savanna periodically in African Adventure.
